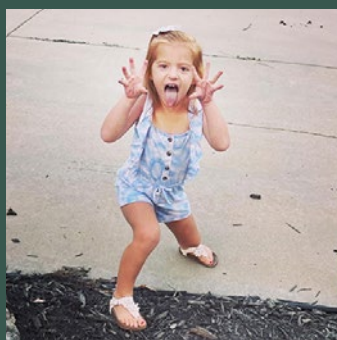

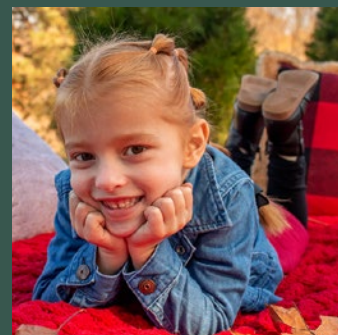


• • ADDIE • •

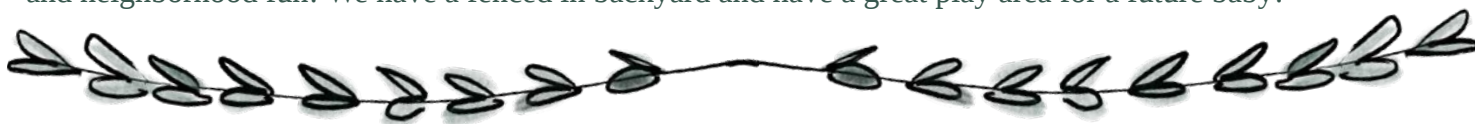

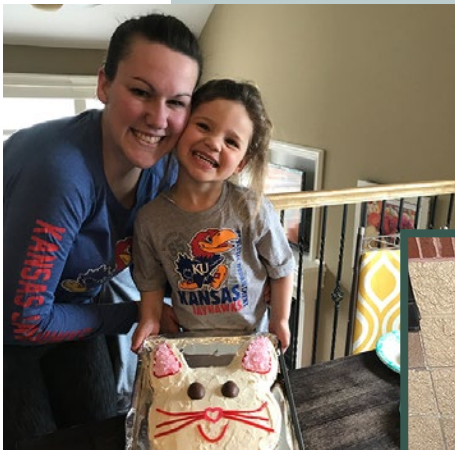

Taylor's Family

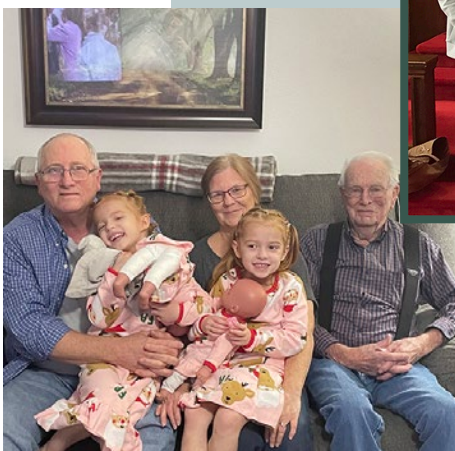
