David's Thoughts...

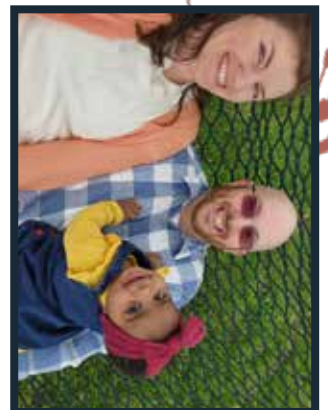
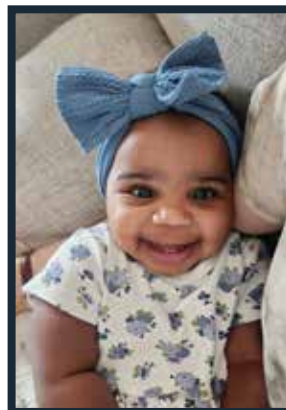

I know if you decide with the great love it takes to allow us to adopt your child, that Kathryn will continue to show him or her that same great love each and every day of their life.



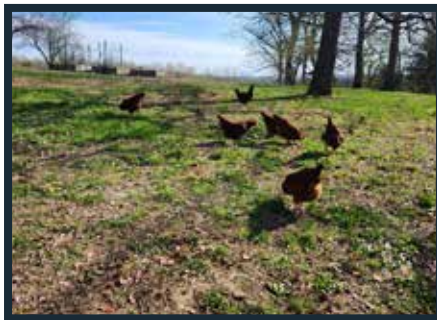
Louise

There are 8 boys and one girl in our family, my identical twin brother and I being the youngest. Though he will deny it, he is technically the youngest child by 14 minutes.

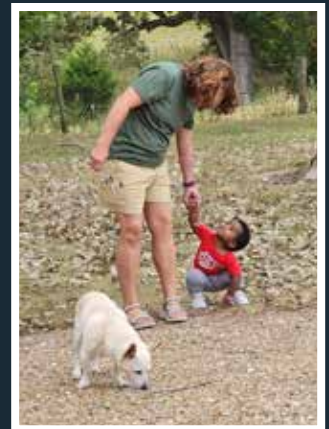

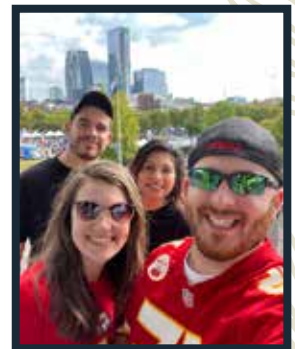
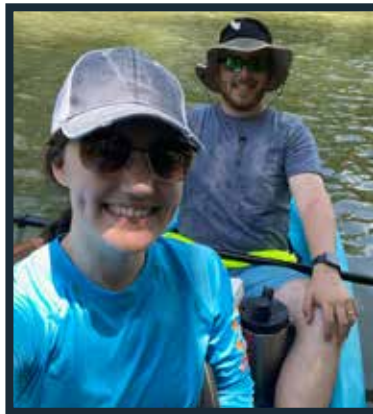
Our Friends
